Pre-Apprenticeship Mechanics Program (specialization in one of Auto Service Technician, Auto Body Technician or Heavy Duty Technician)

## Program Type:

Training for Work (Integrated Training IT)

## Program Description:

A 24 week pre-apprenticeship training program providing essential skills instruction and occupational skills training in one of three streams: auto service, auto body or heavy duty technician. Includes 12 weeks at Motive Action where clients learn from licensed instructors in a classroom and shop setting; and 12 weeks of work experience with employers. Jobs provided upon graduation. Program is provided free of charge

## Program Start Dates and Class Sizes:

Monthly intakes scheduled with approximately 7 – 9 clients per intake.

## Client Target & Eligibility:

You may qualify for Motive-Action's training programs if you are over 18 and:

- are currently unemployed, working temporary or part-time less than 20 hours per week,
  - have been out of the high school system for at least one year,
  - have been a Calgary area resident for at least three months, and
  - are entitled to work and take training in Canada.
- Note: Must have a Canadian Language Benchmarks (CLB) Level 4/5

## Financial Support:

- Program is provided free of charge and income support to cover living may be available for EI, RB, and low income Albertans.
